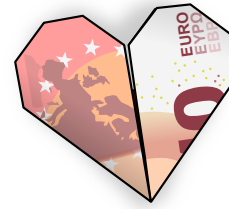
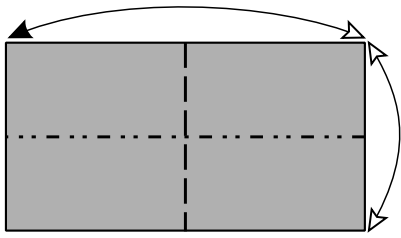


Euro Heart (with locks)

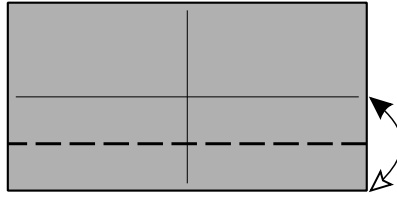

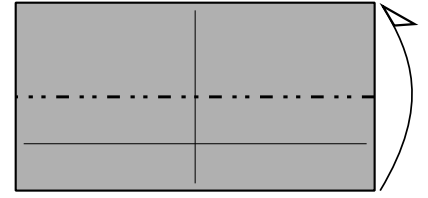
The model looks nice with all Euro bills, for practicing you can use a 1x2 rectangle.



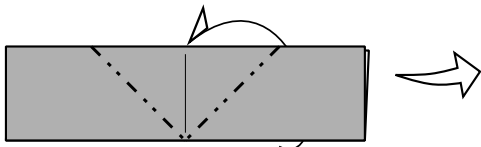
1. Start with color side up. Fold and unfold in half in both directions.



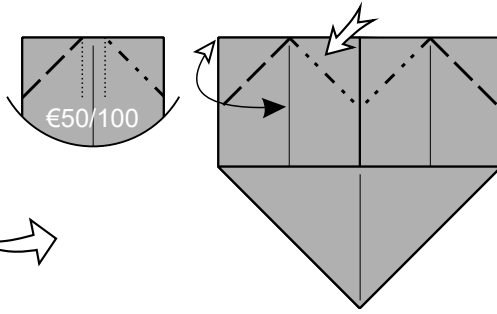
2. Fold and unfold the lower part in half.



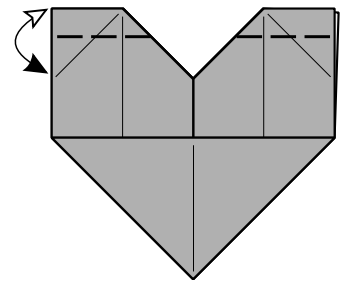
3. Mountain fold in half.



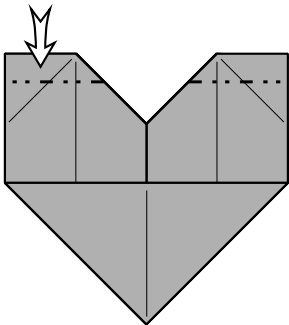
4. Fold both sides behind at 45°. Enlarged view.



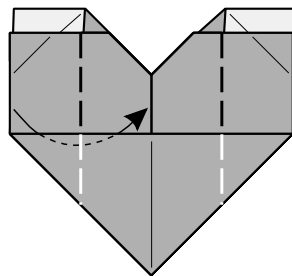
5. Pre-fold the outer corners and inside-reverse fold the center corners. For shorter bills (€50/100) leave a small gap.



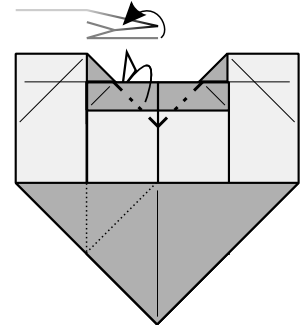
6. Fold and unfold. Pick a height that makes a nicely rounded heart.



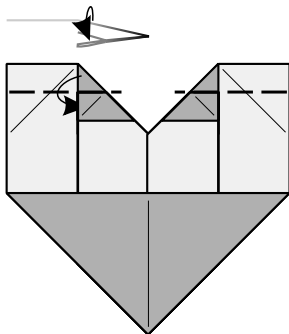
7. Inside-reverse fold the top layer.



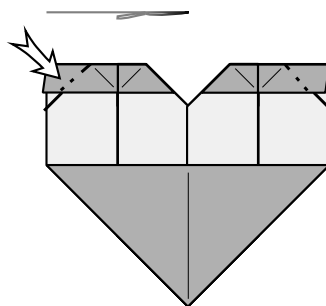
8. Valley fold the upper layer over. Two layers move together in the pocket.



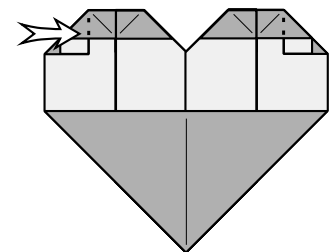
9. Tuck the corners into the pockets.



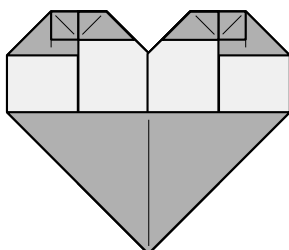
10. Fold down and tuck into the pockets.



11. Inside-reverse fold.



12. Move flaps to the other side (sink).



13. Turn over.
