Use a 15x15cm paper for a 8cm high model.



1. Start with the color of the skirt down. Fold in half.



4. Open sink. Repeat behind.



7. Inside reverse fold all layers together.



11. Round the head with mountain folds.



15. Add a small crimp to the flippers to rotate them slightly. the neck with mountain folds.



2. Fold top layer down. Repeat behind.



5. Fold the top flap over as far as it will go. Repeat behind.



8. Inside reverse fold again at 22.5° resulting in a 90° top right corner.

12. Fold the flipper up.

27. Pull top layers to the right and up.



28. Add additional pleats to the skirt.



29. Inside reverse fold the top layer.



23. Tuck the bottom layer into the pocket.



31. Lock the two internal layers at the back of the skirt by folding them over.



32. Shape the bottom of the skirt with mountain folds.
